

What category does this garbage belong to?


**Start**

Proceed along the course diagram according to the answers of "YES" or "NO" questions.

When it is made of two or more different materials and can be separated easily by hand, please separate in consideration of each material and categorize accordingly. When it cannot be separated, it should be categorized according to the material which contains the larger amount.

Illegal dumping is a crime!
No illegal dumping!Is it a TV (cathode-ray tube, plasma display or liquid crystal display), air conditioner, washing machine, clothes dryer, freezer, refrigerator, personal computer, or fire extinguisher?

What material is it made of?



Recyclable plastics
Transparent bags with yellow print
City-approved bags

Plastic vessels (container)/wrapping (package)/protective material

Caution
Make sure not to mix the recyclable garbage with kitchen garbage, paper, wood, metal, glass, pottery or plastic-made articles.

Nonburnable garbage
Transparent bags with red print
City-approved bags

Metal/glass/pottery/bag/others

Caution
Make sure not to mix it with recyclable plastics or other recyclable garbage.

Recyclable garbage
Transparent bags with blue print
City-approved bags

Drink bottle/food bottle/drink can/plastic bottle

Caution
Make sure not to mix garbage with other foreign matter such as cigarette butts.

Burnable garbage
Milky-white bags with green print
City-approved bags

Kitchen garbage/rubber/leather/wood scrap

Caution
Make sure to dry kitchen garbage.

Paper resources

- Newspapers**
Newspapers may be folded into four or eight.
Caution Flyers should be removed and disposed of as a category of flyers/magazines.
- Corrugated cardboard**
Cardboard having an air layer.
Only corrugated cardboard box
Caution Do not mix garbage with paperboard (thick paper), plastic sheets and expanded polystyrene should be removed from garbage, before disposing of it.
- Magazines**
Empty boxes such as food containers, wrapping paper, paper bags, flyers, medicine boxes (single sheet of paper).
Caution Remove the plastic sheet on a window envelope and on a box of tissues.
- Paper cartons**
Paper carton containers (Should be washed, opened and dried).
Caution A container with a silver inside, should be disposed of as burnable garbage.
- Magazines (books)**
Picture books, weekly journals, novels, catalogues, manuals, and others (Booklet-like printed products).
Caution Garbage other than paper should not be mixed (including paper products included with CDs).

Bind the garbage for each item by using paper string • Corrugate cardboard is not required to be bound. Please fold it.

Collection at bases Bring the garbage to Miyoshi City Hall, each collection site or Miyoshi Environment Clean Center. For details, refer to the Classification Manual (Page 20 and 21)

Used small-size electric appliances
Directly dispose of appliances into the collection box installed at the collection site.

- Digital camera
- USB memory
- Cell-phone
- Car navigation system and others

Re-use books (Books will be reused at a library.)
City-approved bags with blue print
Bags for recyclable garbage are used.

- Picture books
- Illustrated encyclopedia
- Paperback books
- Comic books (series comics)

Recyclable garbage
Transparent bags with blue print bags for recyclable garbage are used.
City-approved bags

Clothes/towels/cloth-made bags/hat/socks

Caution
For reuse, do not remove buttons or metal fittings.
Wash the recyclable garbage before disposal.

Large-sized garbage
Large garbage which cannot be put into a city-approved bag
Electric appliances/furniture/bed clothes/other

Caution
Only tire chains are bound and disposed of.
Never dispose of it as non-burnable garbage.
Fuel must be removed from a stove, etc. Where dry batteries are used, make sure to remove the batteries.

Garbage the City Doesn't Handle

Business Garbage To be carried in personally or collected by city approved operators, (Burnable Garbage), (Recyclable Paper), (Recyclable Cloth), (Recyclable Garbage)

Household Garbage A large amount of garbage temporarily generated by moving or other reasons.

Garbage the City Cannot Collect or Handle

Combustible waste (e.g. industrial waste, tires, drums, cans containing paints, fuels or oils, agriculturals, poisonous and deleterious substances, gas cylinders), automobiles, motorcycles, farm machines, batteries, etc.

Note: When you have a contractor make an extension and/or alteration, repair, or remodel your house, please ask the contractor to take away the waste generated.
